Did you know?

*If you re-used a whole bedding set
this would save around 2.96 kg of
CO₂e. And by avoiding landfill -
one wreath saves around 0.43
kg CO₂e.*

Template for cutting

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Follow our simple guide below!

Step 1

1. Using sharp scissors cut out the template to the left. Use this to cut strips of your unused sheet, duvet cover, or other unused textiles.

Step 2

2. Tie the strips one by one on your wire with a single knot pulled tight. This is easiest if you start with the inner ring on double ring wire frames.

Step 3

3. Slide each knotted strip close to the next until each section is filled - the more strips you can fit the fuller your wreath!



Typically, a fabric wreath can be made from 2 standard cotton-polyester blend pillowcases.

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
